modals (must not / don't have to / doesn't have to) (solution)
Put in: must not - don't have to - doesn't have to
It is Saturday morning. Mrs Miller is making breakfast. Steve is there, too.
Mrs Miller:
1. No, Kate go to school today. It's Saturday.
2. No, thank you. Steve. You go to the door. I can do that.
3. No, thank you. You help me. Kate can do that.
4. Oh no, you wash the toast!
5. Steve, you sing. David is sleeping.
6. Oh no, Steve, you take that box. It's too big. I can take it.
7. No, you <u>don't have to</u> take the cups from the cupboard. They're too high for you in the cupboard. Your dad can do that.
