6. If you put a TV in my room, I won't watch TV in the living-room. (watch TV in the living-room)
7. You 'll get better at school if you don't work hard. (get better at school)
8. If you give me a list, I will go shopping. (go shopping)
9. If you let me go to the party on Saturday, I 'll stay at home on Sunday. (stay at home on Sunday)
10. You 'll get bad teeth if you don't clean your teeth. (get bad teeth)
